A Gospel Reflection

Jesus often refers to the Holy Spirit during this time after Easter, and as we approach the Ascension. The coming of the Spirit of Truth to us is clearly of great importance to Jesus.

How important is it to me? Do I consciously rely on the grace of my confirmation, and recognise the reality of the Holy Spirit in my life?

We are a holy people because of the anointing of the Spirit, and we can rely on the truth of what we believe. The Holy Spirit guides me in the truth. I can rely on the Spirit when proclaiming the Good News, in whatever form my witnessing takes. I ask God for faith and for courage.
